- 1. Approve Minutes from 9/9/24 Ashton moved the motion to approve minutes and Eugen Tui second the motion to approve the minutes. Minutes were approved.
- 2. State of Baranoff and Campus Improvement Plan State of Baranoff Address, Baranoff can not reveal the STAAR scores yet.
 - a. What are we working on Safety we have a working front office door, we are 90% done. Last week we had a TEA safety audit, we passed with a 100% score. A safety concern is we are finding the gates open to the pond, we place chains and locks but they are being cut. The back playground will stay open until 6:00pm Academics big push, district is pushing teachers high quality materials, and Communication bi monthly smore, working on Facebook.
 - b. Our students ECSE, Pk-5, Life Skills and Score, attendance rate is 96.43%, we are currently at 808 students, student diversity. We have lots of support from parents through PTSA and school events. We have 19 new staff members including 3 administrators.
 - c. How we measure student success: MAP Growth helps level students out and a national test, CLI & TX-KEAS, STAAR, TELPAS, Upbeat, Image Math and LEarning
 - d. MAP BOY Math growth rate is 50%, this will lead to student intervention. Student Data information will be handed out during conferences on Monday, October 14th. ELA is 50th growth for this year as well, we are averaging out the same for both tests. TELPAS 85% tested students achieved an increase of 1 or more areas, 39 students took the TELPAS.
 - e. STAAR 2023-24 scores 79/55/18 Math, 95/75/29 Reading, 72/35/19 Science
 - f. CIP Goals: K-5th grade students will increase in math MAP growth from the 42th percentile to 55th percentile. K-2nd grade students will increase in reading MAP growth from an average growth of 43rd percentile to the 55th percentile. On the Upbeat Survey, teacher perceptions around cultural competency, and principal's coffee meetings.
- 3. Staffing Update officially hired the following
 - a. New SPED resource teacher- Luis Figueroa leveled from Casey ES, passionate about reading.
 - b. New SPED TA Allocation waiting for HR to offer a position to a candidate, she is taking a written test and then once she has passed, the process will continue to hire. TA will be used for SEL aspect in the classroom.
- 4. Prop A Mrs. Hassett presented AISD information including AISD budget and recapture. AISD continues to be the highest payer into the state recapture system at \$821 million. Mrs. Hassett explained Prop A that will be on the ballot in November. Information was also given for positions that could be cut if Prop A doesn't pass. Early voting starts 10/21, with election day with 11/5, and homeowners would see an increase in 2025.
